Our ambition is clear: to combine industrial performance with positive impact by reducing our environmental footprint across the entire value chain and by strengthening our social responsibility with the respect of human resources and labor rights. Our policy is structured around **four strategic priorities**, supported by concrete commitments aligned with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

Climate and environmental resources

- Continue **decarbonization our operations**, with the goal of exiting coal by 2026 and achieving carbon neutrality across all scopes by 2050
- Significantly reduce our greenhouse gas emissions, water consumption and waste production
- Contribute to protecting biodiversity
- Promote **responsible sourcing practices** that respect natural resources and biodiversity by engaging our suppliers in a CSR approach

Health, safety, quality and compliance

- Ensure the safety and quality of our products, processes and work environment
- Ensure regulatory compliance across all our activities
- Implement best practices for employee safety, health and well-being

Innovation and sustainable value creation

- Invest in equipment and technologies that reduce our environmental footprint
- Integrate circular economy principles throughout all our value chains
- Design and develop solutions that serve both people and environment

- Continuously improve quality of life and working conditions
- Promote a meaningful social dialogue with all our stakeholders
- Foster diversity, inclusion and continuous development of our employees' skills
